Unstoppable Power Discussion Guide Unstoppable Power Of God's Word - Lesson 1 (July 14, 2024)

This study guide is based on the message that is available on YouTube.

Opening Discussion: Share a time the power went out and how you had to cope.

Dive Deeper:

- 1. Read Genesis 1 and list the things God's words brought into existence. What parts of creation leave you awestruck?
- 2. Read Luke 1:30-37 and discuss the awe and wonder of the incarnation. If God can speak the universe into existence, why would anyone doubt his ability to form a baby in the womb of a virgin? Read John 1:1. Who is the Word referring to in this verse?
- 3. Read James 1:21, Romans 1:16 and 10:17 and discuss what happens when an individual hears God's Word and accepts it. How can you have a part in someone hearing God's Word? How does this inspire you to share the Good News?
- 4. Read 2 Timothy 3:15-17 and discuss the ways God's Word guides and equips us. Share how the Word of God has helped you live out your life.
- 5. Read Matthew 4:1-11. How did Jesus rely on the power of God's Word when facing temptation? How does this emphasize the importance of knowing scripture? Share the Bible passages you rely on in times of need or temptation.
- 6. What can you do to increase your awareness of the power of God's Word? What things or temptations does the enemy use to prevent you from discovering the power of God's Word?

Application: How will you apply Sunday's message and this discussion to your life?
