## Unstoppable Power Discussion Guide Unstoppable Power of God's Love- Lesson 5 (August 11, 2024)

**Opening Discussion:** Share how you sense or feel God's love?

## Dive Deeper:

- 1. According to Daniel 9:9, Lamentations 3:22-23, 1 John 3:16, 4:18, Jeremiah 31:3, Romans 8:38-39, and Hebrews 13:8, how is God's love described? Discuss other descriptions of God's love.
- 2. Read Matthew 26:48-54. Discuss how the power of God's love was displayed in Jesus' actions. Why did Jesus' love withstand the temptation to call down the angels? Share a time God's love gave you the power to be obedient to his Word.
- 3. Read Matthew 27:35-44. Discuss how the power of God's love was demonstrated through Jesus' crucifixion. What held Jesus to the cross?
- 4. Jesus refrained from retaliating while he hung on the cross. Share how difficult it would be for you to withstand mockery, unjust treatment, being called a liar, or ridicule for trusting God as Jesus did. How has Jesus' example of God's love helped you to withstand difficult situations?
- 5. According to Ephesians 2:4-5 how does the power of God's love transform us? Share how the love of God in someone's life inspired you to seek Jesus.
- 6. Read 1 John 4:16, 19, John 14:15, and Luke 6:27-35. Discuss how the power of God's love governs our actions, fleshly desires, and daily decisions. Share how God's love has transformed you to love your enemies or extend grace to others.
- 7. Read John 3:16 and Romans 8:35-37(NIV). Because of God's sacrificial love, what hope do these verses offer us as we face earthly challenges and eternity?

**Encouragement:** God's sacrificial love not only saves us from our sin, but his love empowers our hearts to live for him no matter who or what we may face.
