Shine Your Light Discussion Guide Radiate - Lesson 3 (November 3, 2024)

This study guide is based on the message that is available on YouTube.

Opening Discussion: Other than your salvation, share something that gives you joy.

Dive Deeper: Act 13:47-48a and Romans 10:9-15.

- 1. How is lifestyle evangelism, living a life that reflects Jesus, different from conversational evangelism mentioned in Romans 10:14? Why are both vital? Why is it sometimes difficult to share our faith?
- 2. According to Romans 10:9-10 how would you answer someone who asks you, "How can I become a Christian?" Why is the simplicity of salvation a deterrent for some people to believe in Christ? Did you struggle to accept these simple steps?
- 3. Who can be saved according to Romans 10:11-13 (NLT)? What cultural or social barriers may cause people to hesitate from sharing the gospel with *anyone*? How was Paul, and how were the disciples, at risk when they shared the gospel with *everyone*? Share a risk you took to share your love of Jesus with an individual.
- 4. Read Romans 10:14-15, and discuss the importance of missionaries who are willing to go around the world to share the gospel. What risks and challenges may they encounter? How can we pray for them?
- 5. Read Philippians 4:15-16 and 2 Corinthians 8:1-5, and discuss various responsibilities of the local church and individuals in the world-wide effort of sharing the Good News overseas.
- 6. How do you respond to the following scripture? But my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned to me by the Lord Jesus the work of telling others the Good News about the wonderful grace of God. Acts 20:24 How can Impact 2024 help you finish the work assigned to you by Jesus?
